

An Ordinance of the Borough of Wampum,
Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, Regulating the
Presence of Minors on the Streets of the Borough,
Prohibiting Disorderly Conduct on the Streets of
the Borough, Defining Same and Prescribing Penal-
ties for Violations Thereof

Be it enacted and ordained by the Council of the Borough of
Wampum, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted
and ordained as follows:

SECTION 1

It shall be a violation of this ordinance for any person who
has not attained his eighteenth (18th) birthday to be on the public
streets of the Borough of Wampum after the hour of ten (10) o'clock
P.M. unless such person shall be in the company of a parent or an
adult relative of his family.

SECTION 2

It shall be unlawful for any adult person who has custody or
shall be in charge of any person who has not attained his eighteenth
(18th) birthday to permit such person to be on the public streets
of the Borough after the hour of ten (10) o'clock P.M. unless such
person shall be in the company of a parent or adult relative of his
family.

SECTION 3

Disorderly conduct is hereby prohibited within the Borough of
Wampum. Any person who shall be guilty of any act, word or conduct
causing or tending to cause a disturbance of the peace and good or-
der of the Borough, or causing or tending to cause any danger, dis-
comfort, or annoyance to any of the inhabitants of the Borough, or
users of the Borough streets; or who shall willfully make any loud,
boisterous or unseemly noise or disturbance or who shall riot,
fight or quarrel or incite others to riot, fight or quarrel; or who

shall publically make use of obscene or indecent language; or who shall loaf or loiter or congregate upon any of the public streets or public grounds in the Borough, or upon private property where the owner or lease holder shall request their removal, to the annoyance of peaceable residents nearby or traveling upon any street or being lawfully upon any of the public grounds in the Borough, whereby the public peace is broken or disturbed or the traveling public annoyed, shall be guilty of disorderly conduct.

SECTION 4

Any person who shall violate Section 1 of this ordinance shall be taken to the Borough Building or such other place as the Mayor shall designate, and his parents shall be notified to come to such place for him.

Any person who shall violate Section 2 or Section 3 of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than TEN DOLLARS (\$10.00) nor more than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.00) and costs of prosecution and in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment in the county jail for not more than thirty (30) days.

SECTION 5

Any ordinance or part of an ordinance conflicting with this ordinance is hereby repealed insofar as the same is in conflict with this ordinance.
